An Enactment to provide for the payment into the State Water Supply Fund of sums appropriated from the general revenues of the State or received by loan from the Federation.

[21st December, 1959.]

Whereas on 21st day of December, 1959, the Preamble Legislative Assembly did by resolution in accordance with sub-section (4) of Section 26 of the Financial Procedure Ordinance, 1957, specify a fund entitled the Water Supply Fund to be applied for the purpose of providing for the water supplies of the State of Perak:

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Legislature of the State of Perak as follows:

1. This Enactment may be cited as the Perak State short title. Water Supply Fund Enactment, 1959, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 21st day of December, 1959.

2. There shall be paid into the Perak State Water Supply Fund (hereinafter referred to as "the Fund"):

Payment Fund.

- (a) such sums as may from time to time be appropriated by law for the purposes from the Consolidated Revenue Account of the State; and
- (b) sums representing the proceeds of any loan received by the State in accordance with the law authorising the loan for any purposes which shall have been specified in accordance with Section 3 as purposes of the Fund.
- 3. All moneys in the Fund shall be applied only to such Purposes to purposes as may be specified by resolution of the Legislative be specified by resolu-Assembly.

4. (1) The Ruler in Council shall in respect of every proposals financial year cause to be laid before the Legislative to be laid before the Fund for the proposed expenditure out of Legislative Assembly. the Fund for that year, and of the sums necessary to meet Assembly. each item of expenditure.

Approval of expenditure and appropriation of sums necessary.

(2) The Legislative Assembly may by resolution approve all or any of the expenditure or any part thereof shown in such statement, and shall by resolution appropriate the sums necessary to meet such approved expenditure for the purposes specified in such resolution.

Supplementary Expenditure. (3) If in respect of any financial year it is found that the amount appropriated is insufficient or that a need has arisen for expenditure for a purpose for which no amount has been appropriated by a resolution of the Legislative Assembly, a supplementary statement showing the sums required to be spent shall be laid before the Legislative Assembly, and the Legislative Assembly may by resolution approve all or any of such expenditure or any part thereof, and shall by such resolution appropriate the sums necessary to meet such approved expenditure for the purposes specified in the resolution.

End of Financial year.

(4) All appropriations made under this section shall lapse at the end of the financial year and any balances remaining in the Fund shall thereafter be available for further appropriation:

Provided that, if the purpose for which any sum shall have been appropriated remains uncompleted at the close of the year, the Mentri Besar may direct that any balance of such appropriation shall not lapse but shall be applied for the completion of such purpose during the ensuing year.

(5) If it appears to the Mentri Besar expedient in order to effect the purposes of the Legislative Assembly to alter the proportions assigned to the items shown in the statement referred to in sub-section (1) or (3) the Mentri Besar may direct that there shall be applied in aid of any such item which may be deficient a further sum out of any surplus arising on any other item or out of any unappropriated balance provided that the total amount appropriated by a resolution passed under sub-section (2) or (3), as the case may be, is not thereby exceeded.
