KINTA DISTRICT—CONTROL OF TINNED FOODS

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph (10) of Regulation 17EA of the Emergency Regulations, 1951, I, David Alford Somerville, District Officer, Kinta, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the **Ulu Kinta Sub-District (Control of Tinned Goods) Order, 1953.**

2. This Order shall apply to that portion of the mukim of Ulu Kinta, bounded on the East, North and West by the district boundary and on the South following the course of the Sungei Meru from the point where it joins the West boundary of Kinta District to the point where it crosses the Jelapang-Chemor Road and from that point to the South-west corner of Kampong Tawas New Village and thence in a south-easterly direction to the Kinta River at Map Reference VJ.924768 and from that point upstream along the Kinta River to its confluence with the Sungei Seno-oi and thence along the Sungei Seno-oi to the district boundary.

3. Traders licensed and authorised to deal in restricted foodstuffs shall puncture or open any tin of foodstuffs excluding milk sold by him other than to a licensed trader before such tin leaves his premises.

An Enactment to make provision for the public service of the State for the year 1954.

[1st January, 1954.]

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by His Highness the Sultan with the advice and consent of the Council of State as follows:

Short title
and com-
mencement

1. This Enactment may be cited as the Supply (1954) Enactment, 1953, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1954.

2. A sum not exceeding fifty-eight million, six hundred and seventy-three thousand, and sixty-eight dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenues and other funds of the State of Perak for the service of the year 1954 and the said sum may be expended as specified in the Schedule to this Enactment.
