ENACTMENT No. 5 OF 1951.

I ASSENT

RAJA YUSSUF,  
*Sultan of Perak.*

27th December, 1951.

An Enactment to make provision for the public service of the State for the year 1952.

[1st January, 1952.]

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by His Highness the Sultan with the advice and consent of the Council of State as follows:

1. This Enactment may be cited as the Supply (1952) Enactment, 1951, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1952.

2. A sum not exceeding forty-six million, eight hundred and fifty-six thousand, two hundred and seventy-six dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenues and other funds of the State of Perak for the service of the year 1952 and the said sum may be expended as specified in the Schedule to this Enactment.
