An Enactment to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Fund for additional expenditure for the service of the year 1961, and to appropriate such a sum for certain purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Perak as follows:

1. This Enactment may be cited as the Third Supplementary Supply (1961) Enactment, 1961. Short title.

2. (1) The issue of a sum not exceeding four million, six hundred and forty-one thousand three hundred and fifty-nine dollars (\$4,641,359) out of the Consolidated Fund for expenditure on the services specified in the Schedule for the service of the year 1961, not provided or not fully provided for by the Supply (1961) Enactment, 1960, the Supplementary Supply (1961) Enactment, 1961, and the Supplementary Supply (1961) (No. 2) Enactment, 1961, is hereby authorised.
